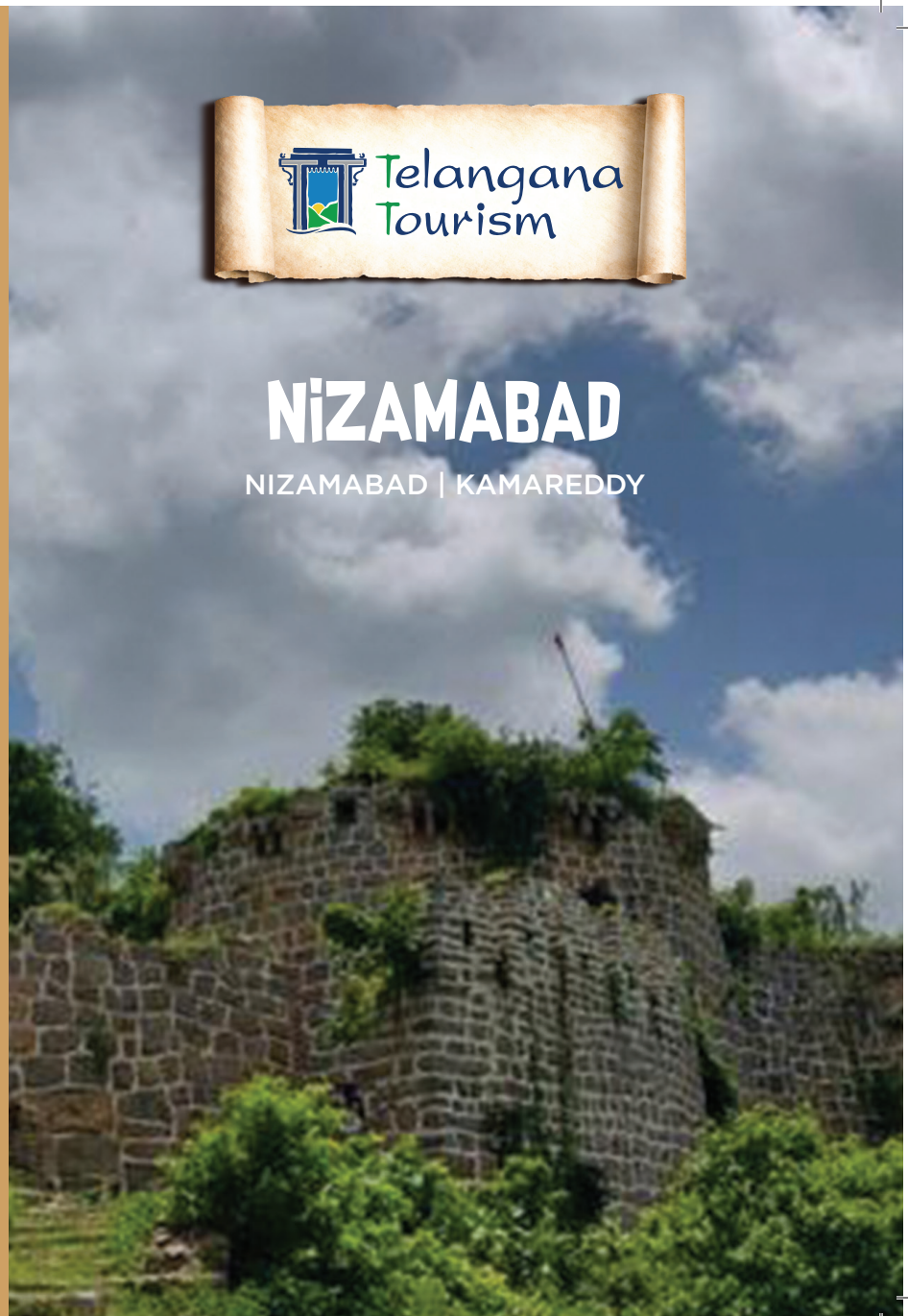

## NIZAMABAD

Nizamabad boasts many picturesque lakes, curative springs, and attractive rock formations that never fail to enthrall tourists and residents alike. The beautifully carved temples are richly carved with architecture that various dynasties have left behind for us to revel in. The Rastrakutas, during the 10th century, along with the rich

influences of Bahamanis, Satavahanas, Qutb Shahis, Asaf Jahis, and more recently of individuals like Allaudin Khilji and Samarth Ramdas, have transformed the architecture of the temples and serene surroundings, lending an appeal of its own. Recently, Nizamabad has been divided into Nizamabad and Kamareddy.

## DOMAKONDA FORT

The Domakonda Fort came into existence in place of an ordinary fort. The Reddy rulers of Domakonda Samsthanam built this strong fort in the 18th century. During Qutb Shahis and Asaf Jahis, the fort was quite popular. The archways reflect the Asaf Jahi construction. Square and circular strongholds are built at irregular intervals. Inside the palace exist two palaces. The Shiva temple reflects an interesting Kakatiya style of architecture.










## SRI RAGHUNATHALAYAM TEMPLE AND QUILLA

The Rashtrakutas dynasty are behind this beautiful town and impressive fort. Rashtrakutas erected a 40-feet high monolithic victory pillar during their famous reign. In 1311 AD, Allauddin Khilji occupied the fort. Later it passed through the hand of Bahamanis, Qutb Shahis, and Asaf Jahis. The ruins of the fort subtly reflect the then strong masonry walls with bastion corners. The fort reflects Asaf Jahi construction, boasting of spacious rooms with a summerhouse. The guru of Chatrapathi Shivaji, Samanth Ramdas, built Bada Ram Mandir, lending a distinct beauty of its own to the fort. Atop the fort, one can have a panoramic view of Nizamabad.

The name itself is a giveaway, which in other words means 'Big Hill Mosque'. The mosque is located between the hills of Varni and Chandur is a popular destination and is thronged by a large number of devotees every year. The mosque is actually the mausoleum of Saint Syed Sadullah Hussaini. Due to the hilly terrain, a ropeway has been installed for easier access to the mosque.

## DICHPALLY TEMPLE

Sitting atop a beautiful hillock is Lord Sri Rama temple, which is gorgeously built with white and black basalt. A traditional yet unique arch at the foot of the hillock beckons the visitors. The temple walls, ceilings and doorframes are exquisitely carved, ushering in a divinity of their own. Towards the south, there exists a large tank, in the midst is a pillared mandapam. The lake's beauty is absolutely awesome and attracts droves of devotees and tourists.

## ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM



The Archaeological Museum houses a wide variety of artefacts and antiques including those representing the early evolution of human civilization right from the Paleolithic age as well as those pertaining to the Vijayanagar period (16th century AD). Apart from these, the museum has an impressive collection of archaeological, sculptural, bronze and decorative exhibits. Bidri articles and a wide spectrum of arms and weapons are also on display.
